

The Moody 425 is a development of the highly successful Moody 422.

The design objective of the Moody 425 has been to achieve a luxuriously appointed cruising yacht that combines both effortless sailing with a high degree of all-around performance.

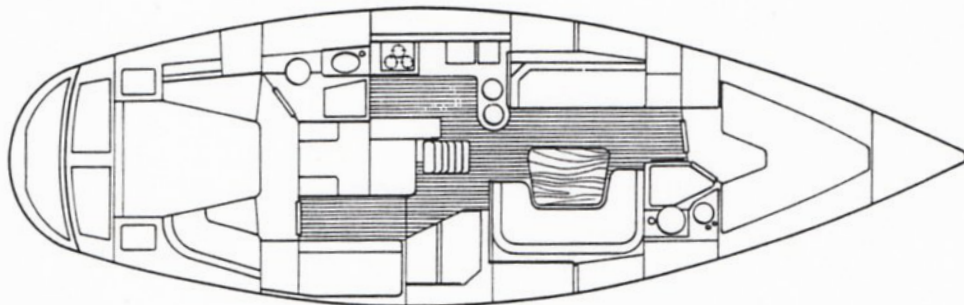
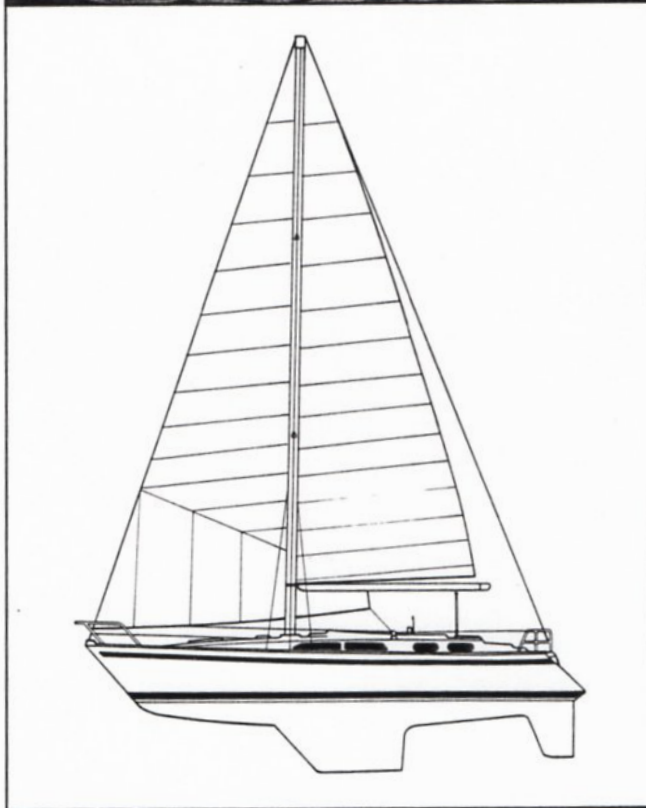
Emphasis is given to care-free relaxation afloat with a large recessed and cushioned sunbed area on the aft coach-roof while the recessed transom, complete with ladder, provides a swimming/boarding platform.

Deck layout and sailplan include as standard both headsail and mainsail-furling systems and self-tailing genoa sheet winches to give easy, uncomplicated handling under sail. The T-shaped cockpit with wheel steering has contoured coamings for comfort and safety. Cockpit seats and sole are sheathed in teak.

Belowdecks the interior layout with its three cabins has been planned with the particular accent on light and ventilation which is provided by twin opening deck hatches, port lights, and four dorade vents. Nowhere are these aspects more evident than in the spacious saloon with its U-shaped settee, single berth settee, and dining table.

No less impressive is the owner's cabin aft with center line double berth and *en suite* toilet and shower compartment. Again, emphasis is given to light and ventilation.

The galley to port aft of the saloon is fully fitted out with twin stainless steel sinks, large



icebox and broiler. Large working surfaces run along both sides of the galley and there is generous storage space.

Altogether, the Moody 425 is, without question, one of the finest family cruising yachts afloat today. She carries a Lloyds Hull Construction Certificate.
