It is an optimized marriage of rig and hull. The revolutionary hull shape penetrates the widest range of wave and chop forms with increased performance. The Five Point Two is a balanced totality of light wind grace, and driving forward in a blow it's more like a swallow than a squirrel.

The cut of the sail is a precision match to the new hull shape and it is crafted by one of America's most famous sailmakers of properly reinforced high grade dacron. This union results in superb high speed balance and control without sacrificing calm wind sensitivity. The combination allows you to accept that last ounce of pull in the widest range of wind conditions.

What's the hardest thing about owning a Five Point Two?... wiping off the grin. Which brings us to the price. Like we said, Tom didn't compromise. You might look at it as an investment in a grin.

When you feel that you're ready, strap on a Five Point Two and prove to yourself that you're as good as you are.
