Quoted from Fleet Captain's notice: "The first Newport 20 Class Race of the newly formed Alamitos Bay Fleet was held in 25-knot winds in San Pedro Bay on Sunday, August 27. The 12-mile course included a running start, close reach, five-mile beat and three-mile broad reach finish. The high winds provided lots of wet and exciting racing with the lee rail under, in addition to a couple of accidental tacks. Most exciting was the finish of the first two boats with Jason's Toy (Ron Hoffman) finishing three seconds ahead of Barbie (Bob Reynolds). Impasse (Dick Van Der Laan) finished third.
