Since her introduction only a few years ago, the Nutshell Pram has been built by hundreds of amateurs and professionals, and has delighted thousands of people who know a good little boat when they see one. Look around the waterfront. You'll see Nutshells at the dinghy dock down by the public landing, pulled up on shore by the picnic rock, bobbing along in the bay behind big cruising yachts, sailing around the harbor with kids at the tiller. We have a variety of ways to entice you into a pram—plans, an instruction book, a video, knowledgeable staff, and several how-to-build courses each summer, right here in Brooklin at the WoodenBoat School.

The 7'7" and 9'6" Nutshell pram kits are available in either a rowing or sailing model. The kit contains all wood parts rough cut to size, fastenings, hardware, oarlocks and sockets, plans, and step-by-step illustrated instructions. The sailing model includes parts for the spars, rudder and fittings, tiller, daggerboard, and case. Shipped from Maine freight collect. Allow 4 weeks for delivery. 9'6" NUTSHELL PRAM KIT

Based on the design of the highly successful original Nutshell Pram, this boat, using scarf'd mahogany plywood, is 2' longer and 4" beamier. She carries a bigger load—more gear or more people or both—has more sail power, and is more stable. Under oars or sail, she's a pleasure to use.



RUDDER-MOUNTING HARDWARE

Strong, secure, functional, and aesthetically pleasing should be requirements for the hardware on your sailing pram or dinghy. With this design you won't lose your rudder in groundings, yet shipping the rudder is easier than fumbling with the more common pintle-and-gudgeon arrangement. Ideal for the Nutshell Prams, the Catspaw Dinghy, and other small sailing boats.
