O'DAY 22

MAINSAIL

Material: 3.8 oz. Howe and Bainbridge dacron medium firm finish.

Dimensions: Luff: 20' 6"

Leach: 21' 7"

Foot: 8' 0"

1/2 height:

1/4 height:

Headboard: 4"

Battens: 1 @ 12"

2 @ 24"

3 @ 21"

All pockets with elastic in ends.

Slugs: Luff only. 12 3/8" nylon slugs at even intervals.
First slug at 18" attached through "0" spur toothed grommets.

Rope: 5/16" for slotted boom

Tack: 3/4" I.D. handworked grommet. 3/4" I.D.
Cunningham eye 9" above tack, handworked.

Insignia: Blue circle 18" O.D., 14" I.D. containing Red
"22" styled according to O'Day literature.

Clew: 3/4" I.D. handworked grommet.

General: Full flow foot.

Sail bag: Large enough to contain jib with main. Synthetic
material, dacron drawstring, marked with boat
type and "main and jib".

O'DAY 22

JIB

Material: 3.8 oz. Howe and Bainbridge dacron medium firm finish.

Dimensions: Luff: 22' 5"
Leach: 19' 5"
Foot: 10' 0"
Leach straight or concave.

Luff wire: 1/8" dia. 7 x 7 stainless steel over stainless steel thimbles incorporating captive shackle equal to Fico FG 446 worked into tack thimble.

Hanks: 8 40mm. at equal intervals. Top hank within 8" of head attached through "OO" spur toothed grommets.

Clew: 7/8" I.D. grommet handworked with leather binding.

Head: 1/2" I.D. grommet handworked into sail and laced to wire thimble.

Sail bag: Packed with main.

GENOA

Material: 3.8 oz. Howe and Bainbridge Dacron medium firm finish.

Dimensions: Luff: 24' ~~5~~ center to center
Leach: 23' 5"
Foot: 14' 7"

Luff wire: 1/8" dia. 7 x 7 stainless steel over stainless steel thimbles incorporating captive shackle equal to Fico FG 446 worked into thimble.

Hanks: 9 40mm hanks at equal intervals. Top hank within 8" of head attached through "OO" spur toothed grommets.

Clew: 7/8" I.D. handworked grommet with leather binding.

Head: 1/2" I.D. handworked grommet in sail laced to wire thimble.

Sail bag: Synthetic material with dacron drawstring, marked with boat type and "Genoa".
