



O'Day's most popular new boat in 28 years was designed to fill all of the coastal cruising sailor's basic requirements. It is a family boat comfortably sleeping four adults, or accommodating parents with two, three or four youngsters aboard. There's an enclosed head, two single settee berths and doubles forward and aft.

The sensible, easily handled sailplan with roller furling genoa jib and easily reduced mainsail, coupled with the shoal draft wing keel, made the standard 272 the best-selling model introduced in O'Day's 28-year history.

Now, a deluxe 272 LE model is also available. You have two choices tailored to fit both needs and budget. A standard 272 can be customized with a selection of options (see current brochure) or the complete 272 LE "package" may be ordered in a unique color with additional equipment unavailable on the standard 272.



Readily apparent differences between the production O'Day 272 and the limited edition O'Day 272 LE are the LE's distinctive two-tone grey hull and deck, Edson pedestal wheel steering and inboard diesel engine.

SPECIAL STANDARD EQUIPMENT/FINISH

1. *Diesel inboard engine*—Westerbeke two cylinder, 10 h.p., with fresh water cooling system for extended life.
2. *Pressure water system*—cold water faucets in both galley and head.
3. *Shore power system*—110 v. three wire grounded hook-up with circuit breaker panel, polarity indicator, two duplex outlets and shore power cord.
4. *Pedestal wheel steering*—specially designed and engineered for O'Day 272 LE by Edson Corp.
5. *Compass*—Ritchie 4" spherical compass with night lighting and built-in compensators.
6. *Self-tailing cockpit winches*—Barlow #19 chrome winches mounted on cockpit coaming for jib sheets.
7. *Second battery*—90 amp/hr. marine battery connected to four position main power switch.
8. *Opening quarterberth port*—4" x 14" screened port opens into cockpit.
9. *Stove*—two burner non-pressurized alcohol stove.
10. *Ice box pump*—discharges into galley sink.
11. *Teak accessory package*—paper towel holder in galley, binocular case on bulkhead, pencil/divider rack, "small stuff" shelf in vee berth.
12. *Plexiglass penboards*
13. *Varnished teak and holly cabin floor*
14. *Double lifelines*—pelican hooks at aft terminals for easy, safe boarding.
15. *Sail cover*—red acrylic mainsail cover.
16. *Boom vang*
17. *Winch handle pocket*—cockpit mounted.
18. *Medium grey hull*—with light grey sheer and boot stripes, red accent stripe above boot. Grey non-skid molded into light grey deck. Below deck, floor pan, hull liner and countertop in light grey.

This special standard equipment on the O'Day 272 LE is in addition to, or a substitution for, the standard boat description of the current model of the O'Day 272.

The objective in modifying the specifications of the 272 to present the 272 LE was to produce a uniquely finished, complete small yacht with the most popular bigger-boat amenities at an attractive package price.

All dimensions and capacities are the same as the standard 272. The addition of the inboard engine and wheel steering increases the boat's weight and displacement by approximately 350 lbs.

Note: The O'Day 272 and 272 LE are not interchangeable. The builder cannot vary from either model's color, standard equipment list or options.
