


Command from her pedestal wheel in the amidship cockpit. The cockpit is deep and roomy with seats for guests and stowage. A flush hatch covers the foredeck anchor bin.

The fully enclosed head has a shower and vanity. The galley is aft, with a gimballed stove and plenty of locker, drawer and storage space. The owner's cabin is aft, with 6'1" headroom. Plus the privacy of a spacious berth, head and vanity, chart table and hanging locker. She's truly luxurious. Carpet, rich teak, formica tops, modern
