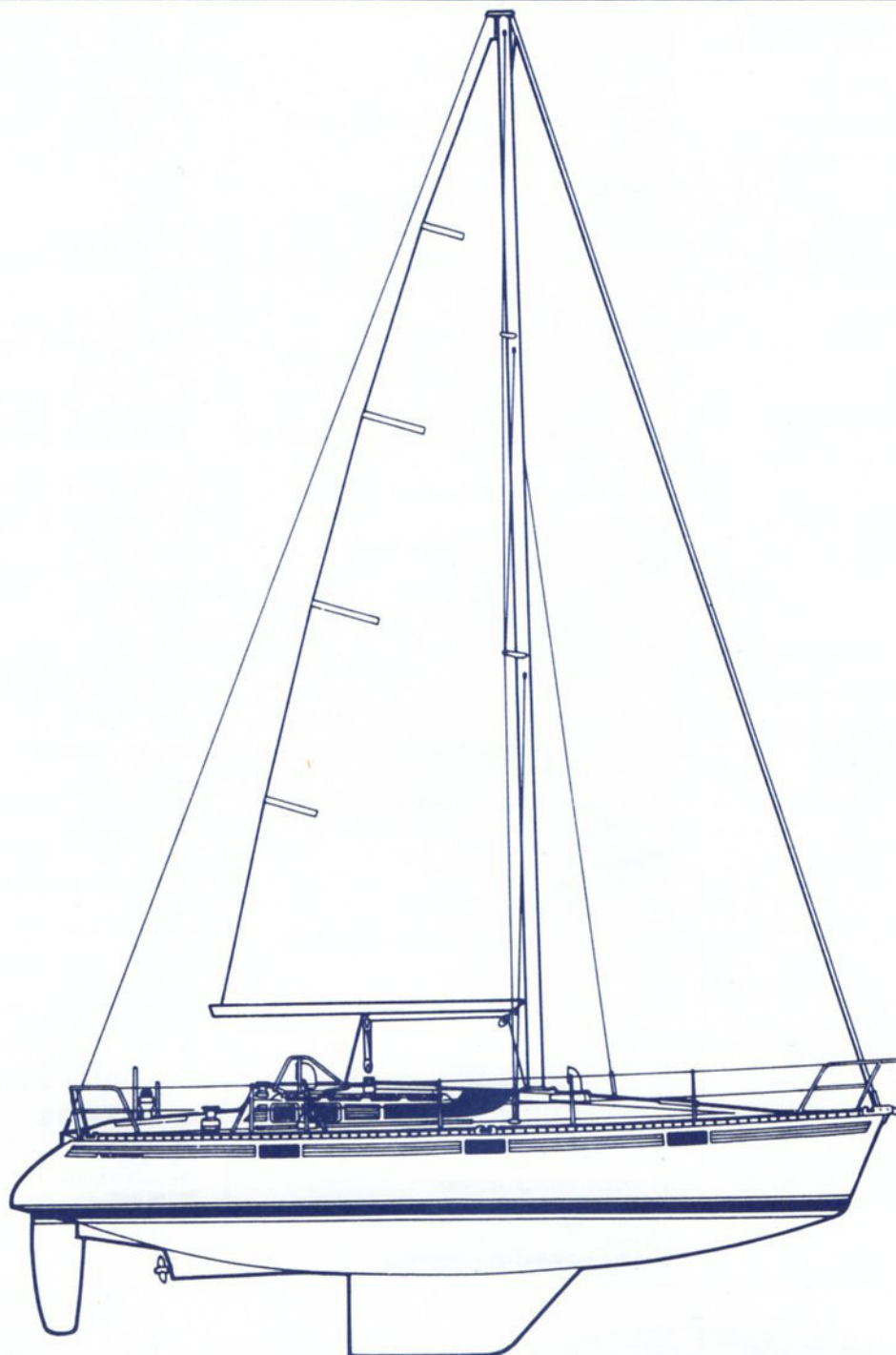

DECK FITTINGS

Bow stemhead fitting with anchor roller, fast tack attachment, and two fairleads with built-in rollers (patented)
Self bailing anchor well with mooring eye
Mechanical windlass
1 opening hatch for lighting and ventilation of front cabin
2 opening hatches for lighting and ventilation of front cabin and head
Pulpit with navigation lights
Opening aft pushpit with horseshoe buoy support and teak flag pole
Anodized aluminum toe rail with 4 fairleads incorporating built-in rollers (patented), 2 aft and 2 amidships
Stainless steel profiled stanchions
Double s/s lifelines with opening gates
3 dorades with s/s guards
Genoa tracks with adjustable car
2 teak grabrails
Mainsail traveller with adjustable car
1 winch Lewmar 30 S/T or equivalent for main sheet with cleat
1 winch Lewmar 30 S/T or equivalent for main halyard and reefing lines
2 footblocks
2 Lewmar 46 S/T (or equivalent) genoa sheet winches with cleat
4 blocks for reefing lines with jammers
2 genoa turning blocks
Slatted teak seating in cockpit
Cockpit table
Teak cockpit grating
Steering wheel (leather covered) with pedestal compass
2 sail lockers with life raft storage in cockpit
1 gas bottle locker
1 bathing platform, teak laid, with 2 lockers
Rubber protection at base of transom
Hand shower on bathing platform
S/s chainplates for shroud, forestay, babystay and backstay
1 winch handle holder
1 double action manual bilge pump
1 aft self-bailing anchor well
1 aft anchor roller
Swim ladder
Companionway step/locker

RIGGING

Anodized aluminum mast and boom, 2 spreaders
S/s standing rigging
Running rig: Genoa halyard, main halyard, boom topping lift, boom vang, main sheet with blocks, genoa sheets, 2 reefing lines, outhaul line

SAILS

Genoa for roller furling system with UV strip and control line of furling gear led back to cockpit through fixed blocks on toe rails
Fully battened mainsail with dutchman system and cockpit led reefing lines.

INSIDE ACCOMMODATIONS

Companionway:

Altuglass sliding hatch
Drop boards
2 grab rails
4 steps with non skid
Removable bottom step for access to engine
Locker
Hanging locker on starboard

Galley-Salon:

Laminated working space with fiddles
Insulated icebox, locker, 3 baskets
2 round sinks
Hot & cold pressurized water with single lever taps
Salt water foot pump, refrigerator drain
Stowing space under sink
Trash can
Lockers along the hull
Gimballed 2-burner stove with propane oven
Safety bar in front of stove
Stowing space under stove
Fluorescent light above sinks
Tinted altuglass skylight around coachroof, shutters
Opening port above stove
Port in hull
Water tankage (145 gal. approx.)

Navigation Station:

Chart table with stowing space for charts
Shelves under chart table
Bookshelf
Panel for navigation instruments
Electronic panel, 16 functions, hinged for easy access to wiring
Fluorescent light
Chart reading light

Salon:

Headroom: 6'5"
Lockers under berths with rigid water tanks (40 gal.)
Table with fiddles, bottle rack
Anodized aluminum mast support
Deckliner with wooden panels, access to mast wires, sliding shutters
Opening deck hatch
Opening port in coachhouse
Fixed porthole
Bar and shelf along the hull
Fluorescent light above table
Cushions and backrests with removable covers
Grabrail
Teak and holly floorboards

Forward cabin:

Double bed
Lockers on the hull
Stowing space under berth
Seat with stowing space
Shelf, drawer & mirror
Hanging locker
Opening deck hatch
2 fixed ports
Ventilation through dorade
Ceiling light
2 reading lights
Curtains
Wooden paneling and vinyl lining

Forward head:

Formica laminated bulkhead
Marine toilet with holding tank
Stowage with mirror and door
Wash basin with hot and cold pressurized water
Opening deck hatch
Ventilation through dorade
Fluorescent light
Accessories: glass with holder, towel holders, toilet paper holder

Aft cabin:

Double bed
Shelf along the hull
Hanging locker with mirror
Vanity
Drawer
Settee with stowage
Two opening ports on coachroof and cockpit
Ceiling lamps
Reading lamps
Ventilation through dorade
Access to back of engine, stern gland, engine water intake and electrical bilge pump

Aft head:

White formica laminated bulkhead
Marine toilet
Washbasin with hot and cold pressurized water
Hand shower
Mirror & shelves
Stowing space under washbasin
Opening port
Fixed port in hull
Ceiling light
Ventilation through dorade box
Shower with teak grating and draining pump
Accessories: glass with holder, towel holders, toilet paper holder

Aft double bed
Aft marine head with separate stall shower
L shaped galley
Facing settees in main salon

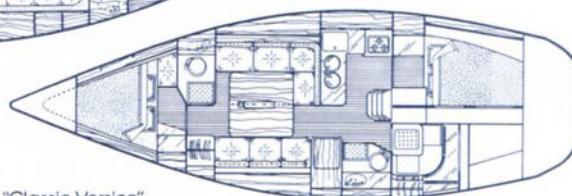
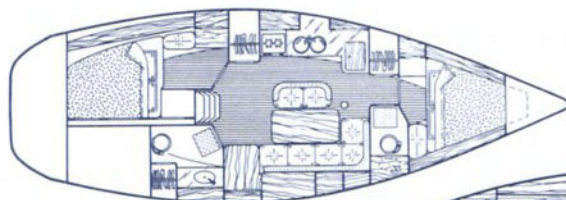
ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT-ENGINE
