

This traditionally styled yacht has a teak bulwark for security and safe footing on deck. In-mast mainsail furling and genoa furling are standard equipment, as is the anchor windlass mounted aft of the split

anchor locker. Her swim platform and ladder are designed for easy access to the water or from the dinghy.

Inside, as on deck, there is plenty of room and excellent visibility.

Unique to this boat is the raised salon table and seating which allows a panoramic view of outside when seated; a feature not found in other center cockpit designs. The master cabin aft features a centerline berth and ample storage for an extended cruise. A bathtub and shower, all molded in one piece fiberglass for easy clean-ups, are star attractions of the aft head.


The galley runs aft from the salon along side the gangway and is fully equipped with all modern conveniences. At the aft end of the salon to port, is a full sized navigation table with plenty of space for electronics.



Forward of the salon is a second head compartment to starboard.



## ON DECK


- 1) Comfort & safety: Bulwark all around deck with solid teak cap.
- 2) Teak lateral rubbing strakes.
- 3) Side opening lifelines.
- 4) Ventilation & natural lighting: 12 opening ports, 4 deck hatches & 4 dorade vents.
- 5) Teak stern-rail seats.
- 6) Choice of hydraulic steering position either in cockpit or on forward port cockpit bulkhead.




SINGLE FORWARD CABIN VERSION
