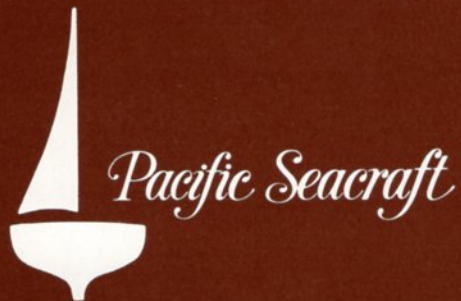

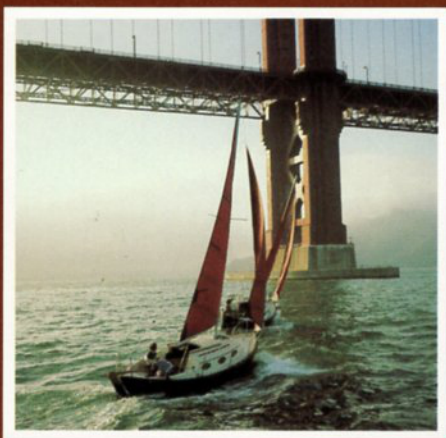
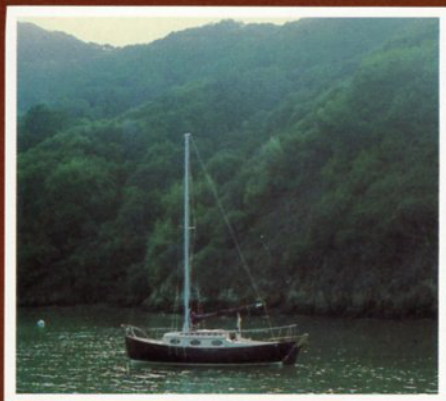

add to the feeling of livable luxury.

On deck the feeling of tradition is carried through with oiled teak cap rails, grab rails, a beautiful oak tiller and white ash rudder cheeks. All cleats, winches, hinges, hasps, gudgeons and pintles are solid Bronze, as are the headstay fitting and all through-hull fittings.

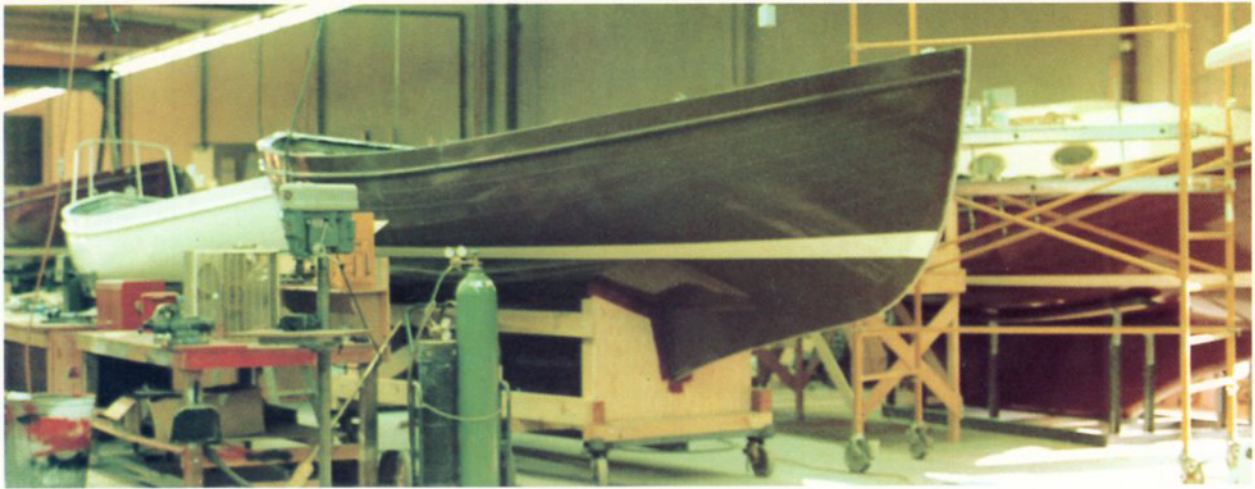
It is this dedicated attention to traditional quality and detail that makes the Pacific Seacraft 25 unique in a world of production boatbuilding.
