

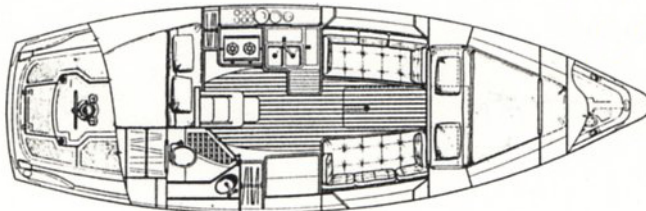
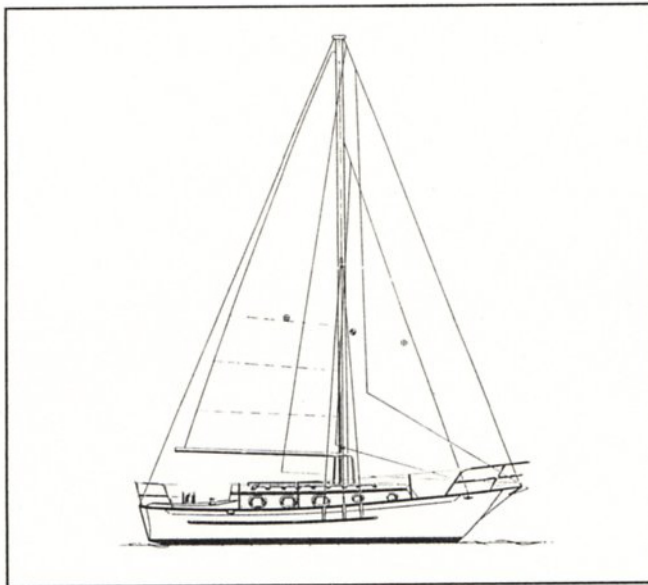
Pacific Seacraft 31

The Pacific Seacraft 31 is a new cruising design from the board of W.I.B. Crealock. The interior is a product of Joseph Artese Design, whose interior designs of the 90-foot sloop *Whitefin* and 72-foot ketch *Victoria* have won him much acclaim.

For the Pacific Seacraft 31, Artese has incorporated two large double berths and two single berths that double as comfortable lounging settees and seating. The aft head location is convenient to the crew on watch.

Her fiberglass hull and deck are built to the most rigorous specifications: 100 percent hand laid-up and squeegeed to remove all excess resin for optimum strength-to-weight ratio. The vital deck/hull connection is engineered with a double flange bedded in high tensile polyurethane adhesive compound and through-fastened with $\frac{3}{8}$ " 18-8 stainless steel bolts.



Strength of construction, ease of handling, and comfortable accommodations make it possible for a cruising family to take a Pacific Seacraft 31 anywhere within the limits of their own abilities.
