Much has been written about the Passport 40, but perhaps Robert Perry sums up best the virtues of one of his most popular designs.





"The Passport 40 is my most popular 40-footer. Few yachts of her size offer as much living area, but perhaps the most marked feature of the Passport 40 is the performance. This design excels in docile and forgiving behavior. The boat tracks well, is very stiff, and always predictable. The small foretriangle with the mast well forward gives this boat a balanced helm and the big main provides plenty of off-the-wind power. The good manners of this boat have made it a particular favorite on San Francisco Bay where the typical afternoon

breeze is 25 knots, gusting consistently past 30 knots. I have had the pleasure of meeting several owners and sailing in three Passport Regattas on Passport 40s; so I've gotten to know this design very well. My strongest impression associated with the Passport 40 is one of happy owners. You simply do not find an unhappy Passport 40 owner. I'm very proud of this design."
