


Pearson 33

The Pearson 33 reflects a trend towards performance cruising boats. Its generous rig, combined with its modern hull shape, gives the Pearson 33 the ability to stand up in a breeze yet remain responsive in light air.

The deck layout represents our latest thinking in terms of contoured seating and angled coamings, both of which provide maximum comfort at rest or underway.

The interior layout features an enclosed aft cabin for owners/skippers and an enclosed V-berth forward cabin, which offers maximum privacy for guests. A full head and wet locker are to port of the companionway along with a generous sized icebox beneath the chart table. The galley to starboard is open and airy. It includes a deep sink and two-burner propane stove with oven. Forward, settees and overhead lockers are on either side, with the L-shaped star-



board settee opening to an additional double berth.

The Pearson 33 will perform favorably under IMS or PHRF rating, so she is well suited as a dual-purpose boat for club racing, whether you opt for the deep keel or efficient wing-keel configuration.
