We designed this boat for the sailor who appreciates innovation and performance. With her generous sailplan and stable hull form, she will perform well in light and heavy air and is ideal for long passagemaking.

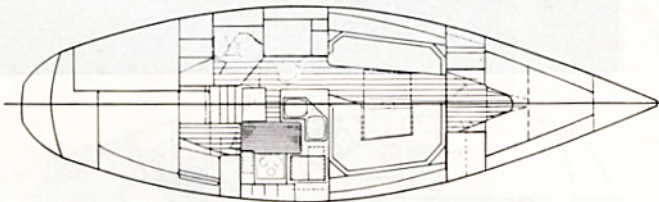
She has a generous deck area throughout and a large cockpit with contoured seating, including helmsman's seat and high backrests.

The main saloon combines both traditional and contemporary features. The sturdy centerline table has leaves, which fold down, and the U-shaped dinette to starboard becomes a double berth.

The chart table area includes a swing-away folding seat for the navigator and plenty of room for electronics.

The galley features a large double sink, a built-in dish rack, and plenty of stowage for provisions and supplies.

A spacious head with



shower is located aft. An overhead hatch and an opening port provide plenty of light and fresh air.

The aft stateroom features a large double berth and, just forward of the bunk to starboard are a bureau and locker.
