

Notes to Sailmaker

- Rig is totally unstayed - hence the tiny flying jib.
- Mainsail laced to mast, gaff, and boom.
- Jib set flying without any forestay.
- Gaff will be fairly bendy, with peak halyard attached at mid-point.
- No battens - cut slight hollow in mainsail leech. However, if the sailmaker considers battens necessary, take sailmaker's advice.
- Main sheet will attach to boom near the clew.
- Sails may be cross-cut or vertically cut as sailmaker recommends.
- Reef Points and dimensions suggestive - sailmaker adjust if required.
- Boat is unballasted and light.

Luff 2200mm (86-5/8")
Leech 5008mm (197-3/16")
Head 3453mm (135-15/16")
Foot 3774mm (148-9/16")
Peak to Tack 5501mm (216-6/16")

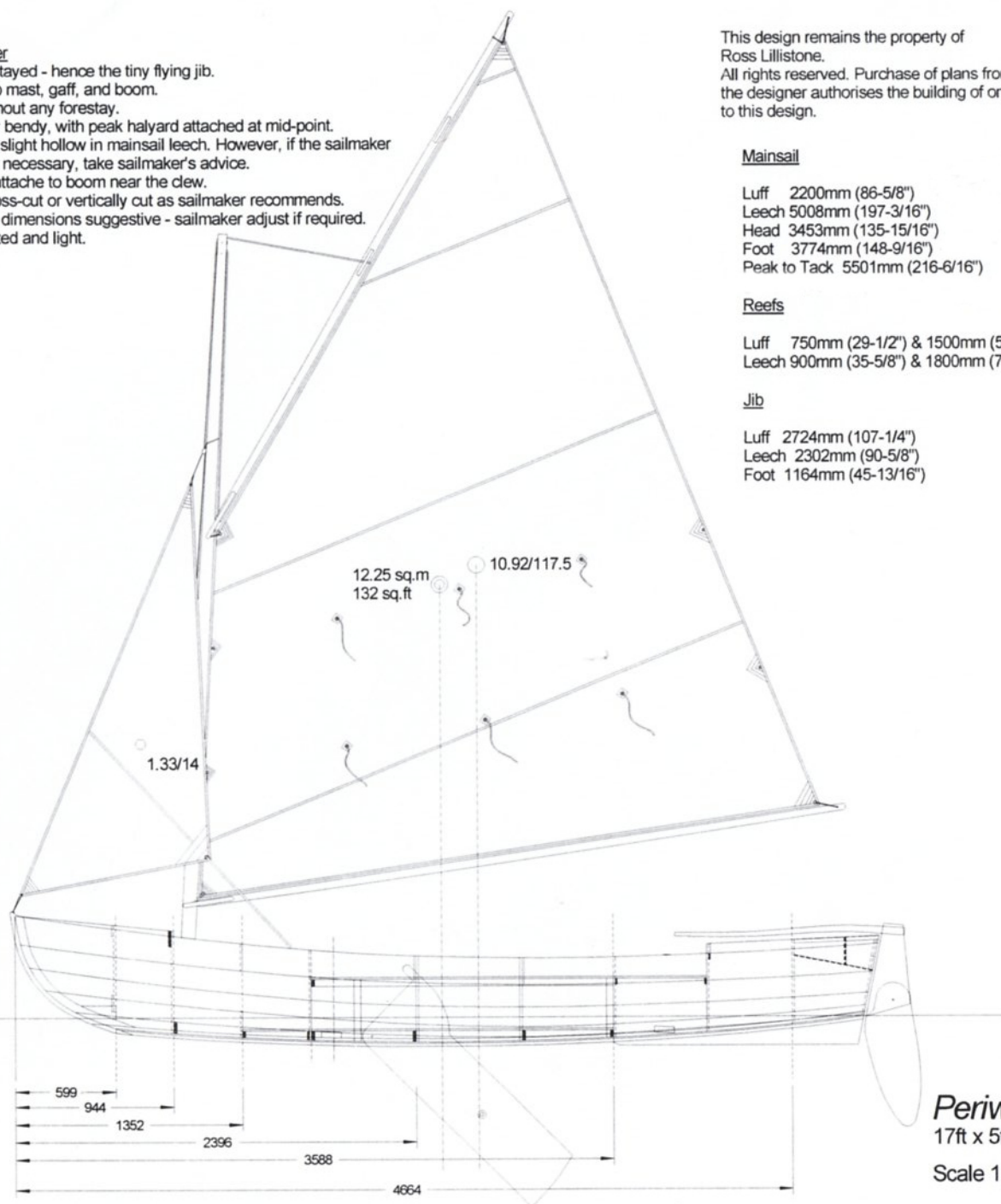
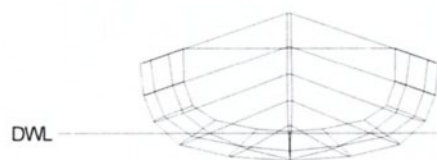
Reefs

Luff 750mm (29-1/2") & 1500mm (59-1/16")
Leech 900mm (35-5/8") & 1800mm (70-7/8")

Jib

Luff 2724mm (107-1/4")
Leech 2302mm (90-5/8")
Foot 1164mm (45-13/16")

Mast is same as main mast in Cat-Ketch rig - see "Masts" sheet.
