Welcome to the Prindle 16 Catamaran, the first choice for quality, value, and performance in catamarans today. As you compare the Prindle 16 to other catamarans, take a close look at the fine workmanship—the polish on the aluminum castings, the heat-sealed mesh trampoline, the careful seaming and handwork of the sails. Inspect the fine entry of her bows, the graceful curves designed for smooth water flow along her hulls, and her cambered and textured decks. Take the main controls in your hands and work the Harken Hexacat mainsheet blocks, the roller bearing traveller, and the adjustable outhaul. Keep in mind that Geoffrey Prindle designed her for comfortable and controllable sailing by an average couple, and you, too, will agree the Prindle 16 Catamaran is truly the first choice.

The Prindle 16 Catamaran is a comfortable, controllable, high-performance day-sailing multihull. Her light weight, rugged hardware, and ease of handling make her the perfect family fun boat. She can drift across a summertime lake loaded down with kids and sandwiches, or she can be jamming to the weather mark, double trapeze, in winds over 20 knots!

The Prindle 16 Catamaran has won the "Most Efficient Catamaran" trophy two years in a row ('75 & '76) at the Pacific Multihull Association World Speed Trials. These awards were earned in competition against all the current production catamarans and many custom multihulls, ranging in size from 14 to 37 feet! In the 1975 PMA Speed Trials she was also awarded the "Fastest Catamaran Under 20 Feet" trophy. Other firsts in against-the-field competition have been logged nationally.

The Prindle 16 Class Association was formed in 1972, has active fleets across the nation, and publishes a quarterly newsletter. The Association sponsors many State and District Championships, culminating with an annual National Championship Regatta. Strict one-design competition is guaranteed by enforcement of the Class Rules, which include the requirement of a current Measurement Certificate.


