



THE GILLMER/KENNER PRIVATEER-35



THE FIBERGLASS Privateer-35 is a large version of the Kenner Boat Co.'s Privateer-26 which was also designed by Thomas C. Gillmer. The new boat, the first of which was launched earlier this year, is designed as a comfortable cruising ketch with offshore capability. While she would probably be classed as a character type because of her appearance above the waterline, she has a modern underbody and easily-driven lines. The designer says these vessels will have an easy motion in chop and be dry and snug.

The Privateer-35 is available in either double-cabin or

conventional single-cabin models as shown. The single cabin plan calls for a shower in the head, while the double cabin version includes an additional head in the after cabin. In both boats, the galleys are exceptionally large.

Cruising range under power is 450 miles with 55 gallons of diesel fuel supplying a direct drive 35-hp. Westerbeke 4-107.
