



Raider 33

The John Cherubini designed Raider 33 presents a 9,300-pound displacing, low wetted surface hull in a 27-foot waterline sloop. The new 33 is offered in three stages of completion as well as in the finished state.

The Raider 33 features a high aspect rig to carry nearly 500 square feet working sail. There is end-boom sheeting to the mainsheet traveller set on the fore cockpit seat.

The accommodation space is in a standard layout with six berths, including transom berths and the large quarter berth to starboard. There's a small L-shaped galley with gimballed two-burner alcohol stove, a stainless steel sink, ice box and pressurized water.

The owner completion program offered by Raider Yachts features three stages of hull to choose from. "Stage One" includes molded hull, deck, cabin, floor support and floors glassed in place with lead keel and chainplate bulkheads. It is offered at \$13,500. Other more completed stages are available at \$19,500 and \$25,667. The completed Raider 33 is \$51,900 with main and jib, winches and wheel steering among its standard items.
