The Reinell 2200 sailboat and 2600 sailing cruiser decks are rounded out to the hull sides. This provides an 8 foot wide work area that is free of deck humps. This type of deck also provides maximum usable interior headroom.

This placement allows for more efficient use of power. The 2200 has an exclusive O/B motor well. Because the motor well is made for an outboard, it won't fatigue like a normal bracket mount.

Reinell Sailboats are a one-piece design. Incorporating a balsa wood core sandwiched between fiberglass strand—roving laminations and hand laid-up fiberglass. This type of construction provides extra strength to minimize stress and hull fatigue. Hull thickness is consistent and uniform. The weave of the fiberglass roving also acts to dampen shock by dispersing impact over a larger hull area.
