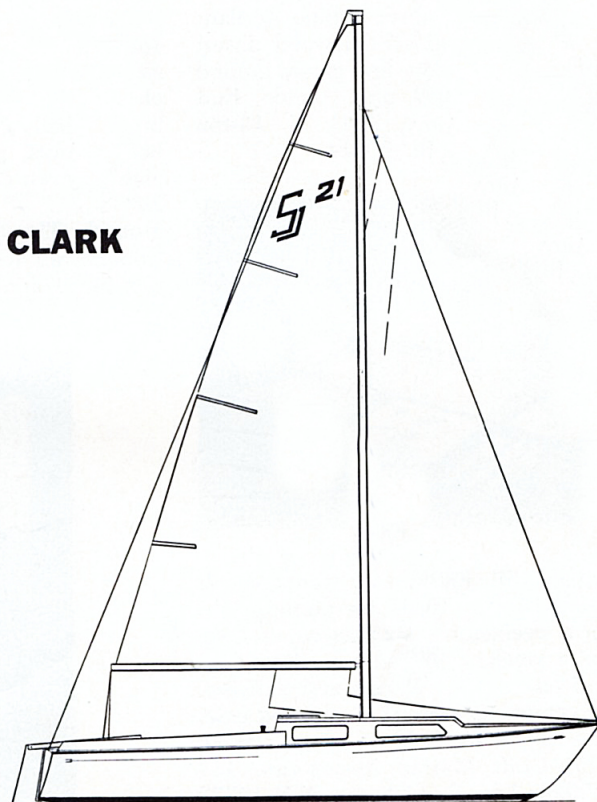
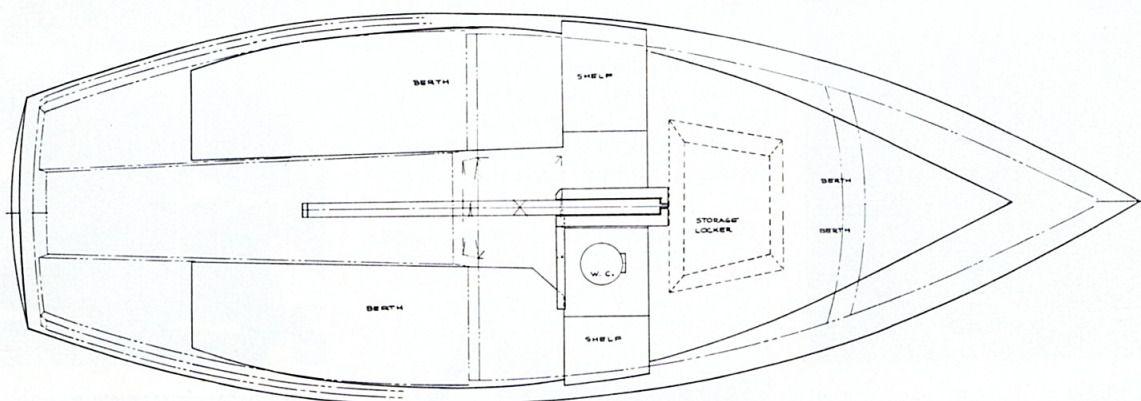

RETRACTABLE KEEL SAN JUAN 21 FROM CLARK

CLARK BOAT CO. has begun production of the fiberglass San Juan 21, designed by Don Clark who, among other things, is married to the '66 Adams Trophy winner, Jerie Clark. This design has a long waterline, flat run, and generous beam for sail-carrying power. Her 400-lb. keel is fully retractable—a concept which is growing in popularity due to the safety and stability of a keel that goes along with trailing mobility. Unlike some other boats of this type, when her keel is raised it is nearly entirely housed within the hull shape. It can also be retracted while underway and may be raised slightly for good performance off the wind. It is said that only 15 minutes are required to rig and launch the San Juan 21.

There is room to sleep four in two quarter berths and a double berth forward underneath which is a storage locker. A marine head is located on the starboard side.
