

The Seafarer-34 is a yacht that will appeal to all members of the family and be a proud possession for years to come.



Interior Option #1. You can race or cruise anywhere in the Seafarer 34 . . . comfortably. This plan provides 6 berths, including the convertible dinette. There are 2 additional optional folding berths to port and starboard in the main cabin. The hull outboard of all berths is double panelled to provide an attractive appearance and effective insulation. Excellent ventilation is provided by a transparent topped amidships hatches over the main and forward cabins and by all-weather Dorade ventilators to port over the toilet room and to starboard over the main cabin. The huge cockpit is 8'3" long. The cockpit seats are deep with high backrests for all-day sailing comfort and all-weather protection. The cockpit coamings incorporate a wraparound spray rail forward. There are lockers under the coamings accessible from the cockpit and three large lockers under the cockpit seats.

Interior Option #2. The table arrangement in the main cabin is altered to a U-shaped layout. This makes the most of the spacious main cabin and, with the optional fold-over table top, provided comfortable seating for 6 around the table. As in the other plans there are very useful lockers and shelves port and starboard flanking the main cabin. There are also lockers under the berths to make the most of all available storage space. A toilet-shower-dressing room has separate entry doors from the main cabin and forward stateroom. Another door provides access to the forward cabin.

STANDARD SPECIFICATION

Construction Solid, one-piece fiberglass construction using high tensile wover roving engineered for stress distribution, impact resistance and flexural strength. Entire hull, deck and complete interior accommodation structure of reinforced fiberglass, Unit-Bonded™ into a monocoque structure permanent strength. Hull molded with an integral fiberglass "back-bone" to resist bending of race-taut head/back stays. Sandwich construction deck using end grain balsa core for lightness and maximum stiffness. Deck structurally laminated to hull. Fiberglass overhead liner for smooth appearance and effective insulation. Seafarer easy clean non-skid pattern on all walked-on surfaces. Dorade vent boxes, wide cockpit coamings and SeaFlair™ wraparound spray rail molded integrally with deck. Recessed cove stripe. ColorSpectrum™ choice of unlimited cove stripe and boot top colors.

Ballast 4,800 lbs. cast lead, custom cast and individually weighed by Seafarer, structurally laminated to hull.

Centerboard Trunk and Centerboard Fiberglass centerboard trunk integral with hull. Hydrodynamically streamlined, reinforced fiberglass centerboard. Stainless steel pennant tube. Centerboard is winch operated.

Rig Modern, powerful masthead rig. Sloop rig standard, yawl rig optional.

Chainplate and Tracks Chainplates 1/2" polished type 304 stainless steel through bolted to hull. Genoa tracks and traveller track, if installed, hard anodised 6061-76 aluminum alloy with stainless steel bolts.


Deck Fittings Solid bronze and stainless steel throughout. No chrome plate or aluminum alloys. Two 10" bow cleats, two 8" stern cleats, two 8" jib sheet cleats, two working jib sheet blocks on bronze deck eyes, main sheet block. Two Dorade ventilators on cabin top. All hardware through-bolted.

Joinerwork Yacht quality joinerwork in selected Burma teak throughout. Teak toerails, taffrail, cabin top trim, hatch trim and hand rails. Lockers under winch bases accessible from cockpit. All exterior teak parts joined to deck with stainless steel fastenings. Sea-Luxe™ interior bulkheads, cabin doors, locker doors, drawer fronts, counter and shelf rims, hand rails, etc, in teak grain with wood surfaces protected by vinyl locked to wood with heat and pressure. Interiors of all lockers insulated from hull and isolated from dirt and damp by mirror smooth fiberglass liners. Dinette table, galley counter, chart table and bureau tops teak grain with teak rims. Stowage traps, lockers and drawers under berths. Interior joiner hardware chrome plated.


Upholstery Unlimited choice of Herculon ScotchGuard tweed upholstery for the berths. Berth cushions and dinette seat backs are polyfoam and the covers have zippers. Dinette fill cushion and double berth conversion cushion for the forward cabin are standard.

Hatches and Ports Reinforced fiberglass main companion hatch sliding on aluminum tracks. Aluminum forward and amidships hatches with rubber compression gasket, cam lock and opening adjuster. Teak grain closure boards on main entry. Aluminum entry sill strip. Three large, well-scuppered sail locker hatches in cockpit. ABS rim plexiglass ports. All cabin hatches lockable.


Spars and Rigging Mast, boom and spreaders 6061-T6 aluminum—the strongest most weather resistant alloy available—custom made in our own shops. All mast fittings, including masthead, type 304 stainless steel. Heavy duty crank roller reefing gooseneck on boom. Standing rigging 1/4" 1 x 19 stainless steel, custom swaged by Seafarer. Turnbuckles 1/2" forged bronze open type with positive lock. Halyards 5/32" 7 x 19 stainless steel, with Da-



Interior Option #3. This layout adds a fixed chart table aft to port with an additional hanging locker aft of that. There is a large shelf for navigation gear outboard of the chart table. A top opening icebox is located to starboard aft of the stove. 8 feet of lockers with sliding doors surround the galley which is L-shaped and located so that it is convenient to both the cockpit and the dinette. More lockers are under the galley. The sink is close to the centerline where it will drain quickly on all points of sailing. An entirely separate icebox for beverages is located to port of the companion steps. **\$18,050**



Interior Option #4. A re-arrangement of doors makes possible enlargement of the toilet room to provide a private dressing room/toilet room combination, located between the cabin. A hanging locker is included within the dressing room. Yet, provision is made so that there is a passage between the cabins when the toilet room only is required. As in the other plans, the forward cabin includes a hanging locker, 2 single berths which convert to a huge double berth by raising a center seat to berth height position, lockers under the berths and shelves port and starboard over the berths. **\$18,500**



Interior Option #5. This plan combines the fixed chart table/extra hanging locker features of the #3 interior with the toilet room/dressing room arrangements of the #4 layout. The toilet room is equipped with a teak grating, a horizontal 30" long medicine cabinet with sliding doors outboard and a shelf over the medicine cabinet. The entire toilet room structure is one-piece, easy-clean fiberglass. All berths are well over 6' long. Headroom in the main cabin is 6'2" yet the cabin trunk is low and sleek. The helmsman has excellent visibility over the cabin trunk from the cockpit. **\$18,600**

with all necessary blocks. Flag halyard to masthead. Blocks maintenance-free lightweight black anodized aluminum or stainless steel.

Rudder and Tiller "Intrepid" type rudder of reinforced fiberglass—will never rot, split or warp. Stainless steel rudder post and bronze top bearing. Stainless steel heel fitting weldment. Custom bronze hinged tiller fitting. Tiller beautifully laminated in woods of contrasting color. All underwater parts carefully faired to minimize drag. Wheel steering optional.

Plumbing Quick-action bronze seacocks on all below line openings. All hose clamps stainless steel. Heavy braided outlet and cockpit scupper hoses. Installed marine toilet. Water tank 60 gallons under the cabin sole and directly above the ballast where its weight is located for best advantage. Fresh water piping clear plastic throughout. Automatic water pressure system to faucets in galley and toilet room. Stainless steel sink in galley. Wash basin in toilet room integral with fiberglass vanity top. Shower sump integrally molded under toilet room sole which is fitted with a teak grating. Top loading 150 lb. galley icebox with drain. Navy type bilge pump. Cockpit self-bailing through large diameter scuppers.

Electric System Starting system is 12v. The engine has a 35 amp alternator which charges a 96 amp heavy duty battery. Switches and fuses for each circuit. All cabin lights have individual switches. International navigation lights are installed: Port and starboard running lights, stern light, bow light and 360° masthead light, 6 interior lights.

Auxiliary Power Universal Atomic 4 or Palmer M-60 engine located in accessible position under entry steps. Water cooled exhaust Bronze shaft fitted with narrow 2 blade propeller (Martec folding propeller optional). Rubber Cutless stern bearing and self aligning stuffing box. Fuel tank 20 gallons (optional larger capacity). Morse engine controls. Instrument panel accessible from cockpit. Engine compartment ventilation in accordance with Coast Guard requirements.

PURCHASE CONTRACT The Seafarer purchase contract requires a 15% down payment (for contract totals over \$20,000), 15% when hull is molded, 15% when entire fiberglass structure is assembled, and 45% when the yacht is completed as notified by Seafarer. As purchaser you are requested, if at all possible, to visit the Seafarer plant at time of completion to personally inspect your yacht. The final 10% is due on delivery, at delivery point specified in contract. Moorings are available in Huntington harbor at no charge for 10 days after delivery for owners taking sailaway delivery. Financing can be arranged at low bank rates for up to 7 years and up to 85% of contract price.

DELIVERY All prices are f.o.b. Huntington, N.Y. plant. Sailaway delivery includes launching, rigging, delivery sailaway at Seafarer mooring in Huntington harbor. For overland delivery, Seafarer maintains a fleet of trucks and trailers which operate anywhere in the continental United States. Rates include complete insurance up to delivery. If no crane is available at destination Seafarer can off load using trailer mounted equipment. Overseas delivery can be arranged to any destination world-wide through the Port of New York. Also available: Welded steel shipping and storage cradle; Botton preparation and painting in your choice of Woolsey Vinelast colors.

WARRANTY The Seafarer warranty is for 2 years on the fiberglass structure and for six months on other parts. Any warranty problem can be notified to Seafarer by telephone, or otherwise. Repair authorization, if appropriate, is prompt.
