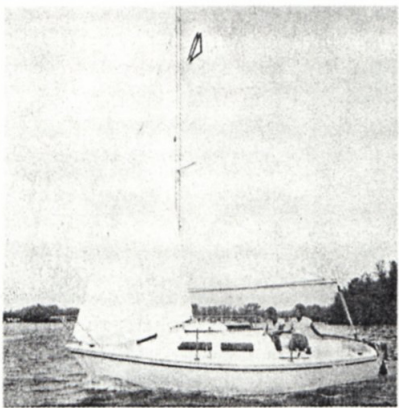


STARWIND 190
