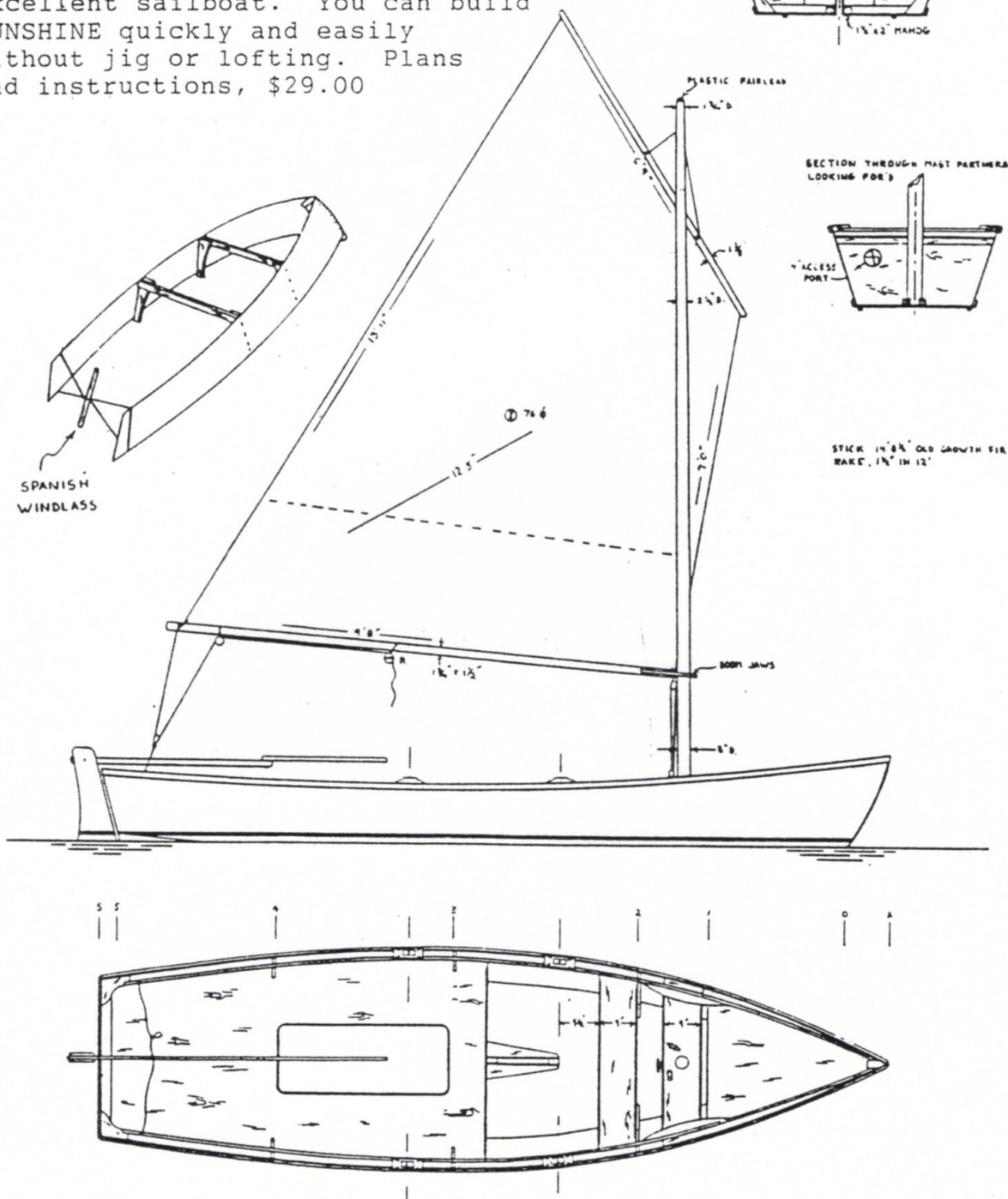

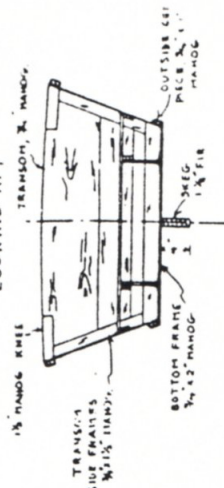

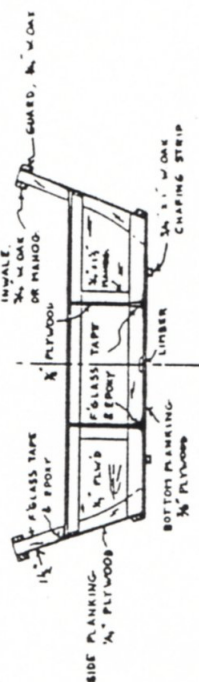


SUNSHINE'S fine lines are based on the writer's considerable experience designing simple easy-to-build flatbottom skiffs. A small outboard motor can be hung over the transom and there is ample flair to her sides for reserve stability and dryness. Sunshine is very good in a chop and her standing lug rig is easily hoisted or taken down and stowed in the boat.

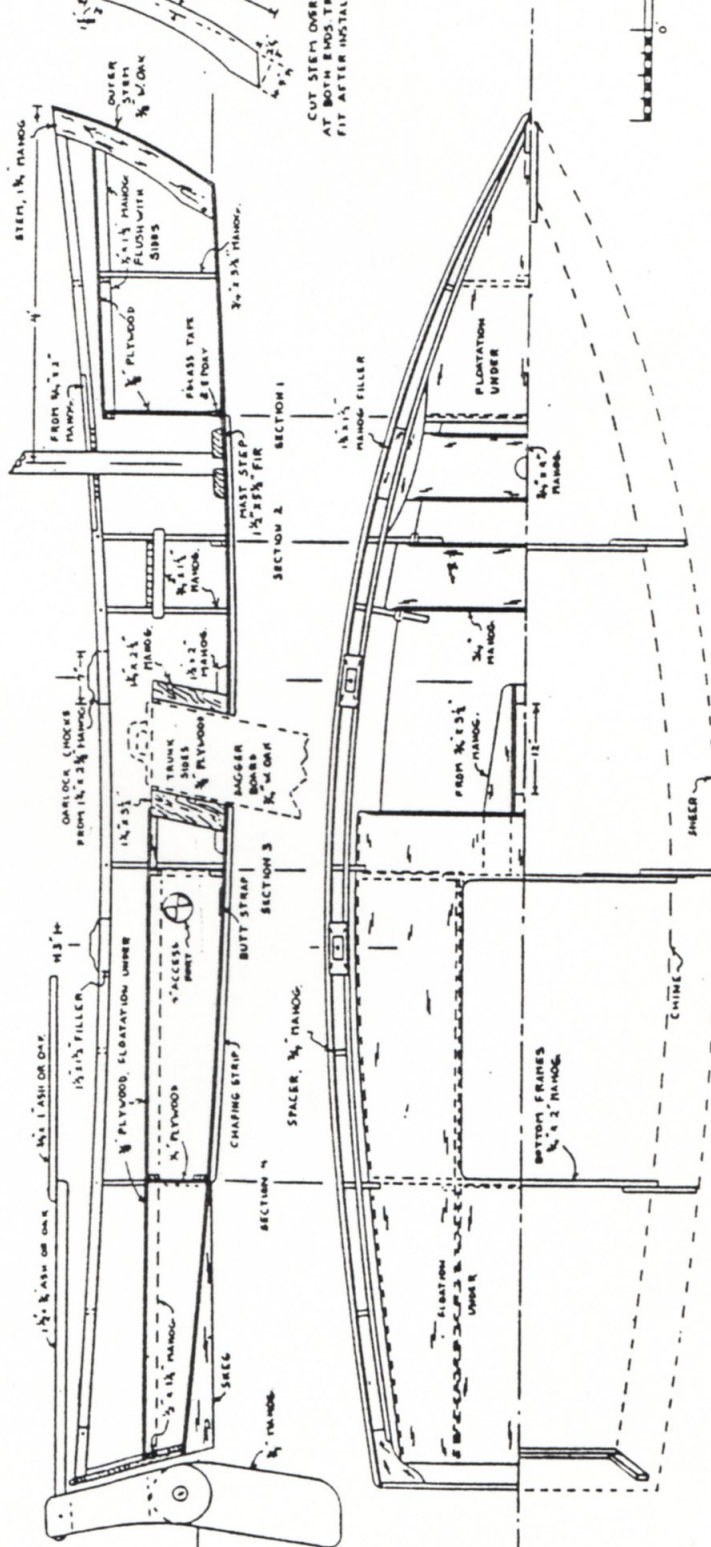
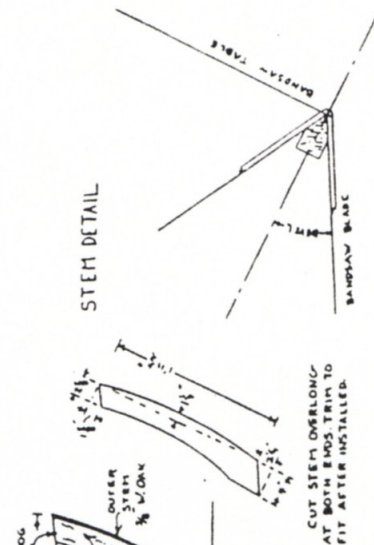
VIEW OF TRANSOM
