

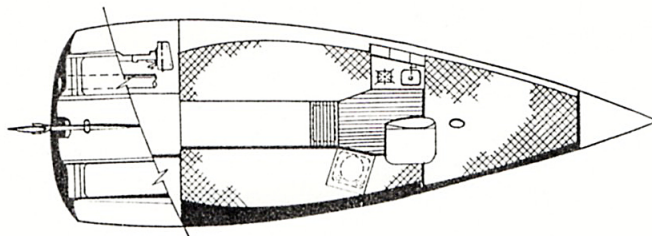
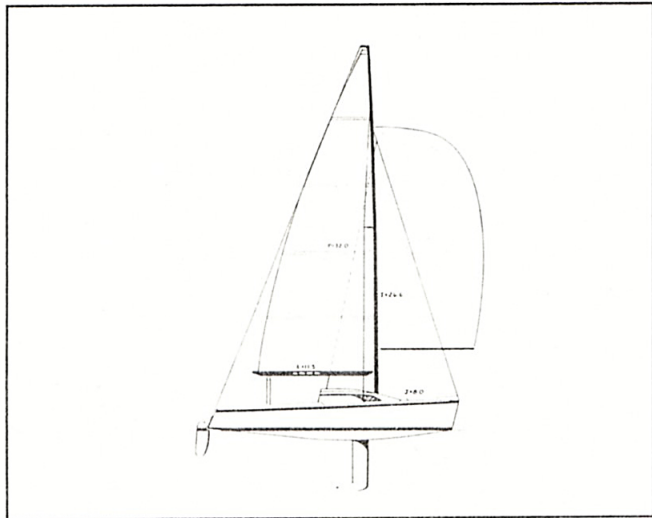
Swarbrick 25

Designed, tested, and produced in Western Australia, the Swarbrick 25 marks the return of John Swarbrick, designer of the Kookaburras, to the arena of ultra-performance sports boats.

By combining light displacement, deep draft, and state-of-the-art planing hull with a powerful but manageable sailplan, the SW25 delivers exhilarating speed with controlled confidence. Upwind performance is remarkable.

SW25 construction and finish are world class. Laminate samples have been tested to destruction, and each hull and deck are full hand lay-ups of Coremat sandwich construction. Hardware is to the highest international standards—Tasker, Harken, Antal, Lewmar—and is mounted on an innovative, functional deck featuring a huge cockpit, not just a foot-well, complete with



motor/gas tank storage lockers and built-in drink cooler.

Finally, the SW25 is truly trailerable. The "daggerbulb" keel retracts into the hull, the boat sits low on its trailer for towing stability and easy launching. Shallow launch ramps are no problem. Every highway becomes a road to distant cruising grounds and racing regattas. A fixed-keel version is also available.
