TANGERINE's modern high aspect ratio rig lends power to her windward performance while her heavily ballasted fin keel and fine hull configuration keep her stable yet responsive even in harsh sea conditions.

Her deck and cockpit are extremely well laid out for ease of sail handling and better control of the helm. Non-skid on these surfaces makes for sure footing on the most exciting tacks!

Unlike other boats in her size range, TANGERINE is a good heavy-weather sailor, sporting strong reinforced fiberglass construction, a self-bailing cockpit, spray combing and self-righting hull features. Full flotation is standard for added safety.

Because the TANGERINE requires only 21" of water, there is no worry of being stranded high and dry when you want to go exploring in some seldom-visited little cove. And after you get there, you may want to stay a while, so we've provided a large airy cabin with accommodations for four adults!

For those who would rather trailer their boat, the TANGERINE is equipped with an easily stepped mast for efficient launching and retrieving.

You really have to get close to the TANGERINE to appreciate the care we put into her construction. When you get finished examining her highly-polished hull, standard in a striking tangerine (or white) color and exclaiming over her quality sails with color-coordinated genoas, try to step back a little to admire the TANGERINE's clean, modern lines. Allow your eye to follow the black anodized mast and boom down to her wide cabin stripe with its inset tinted windows — and below this, one of the sleekest hull configurations in production today! You'll find that the TANGERINE's lines are fluid and very easy to follow!

After all, isn't that the way a sailboat should be?
