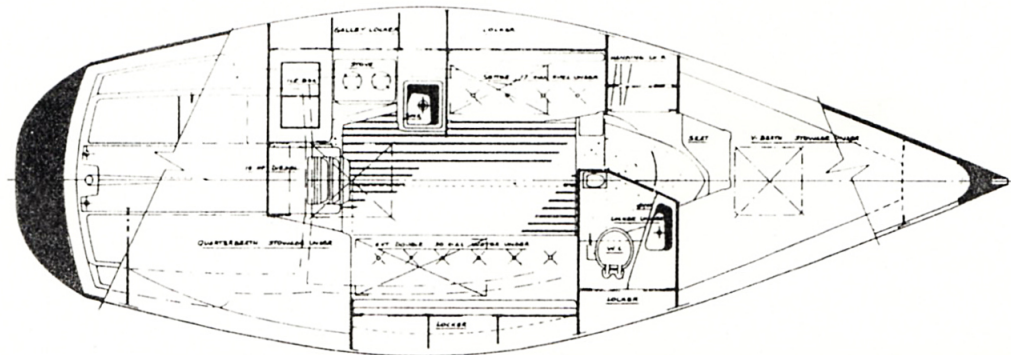
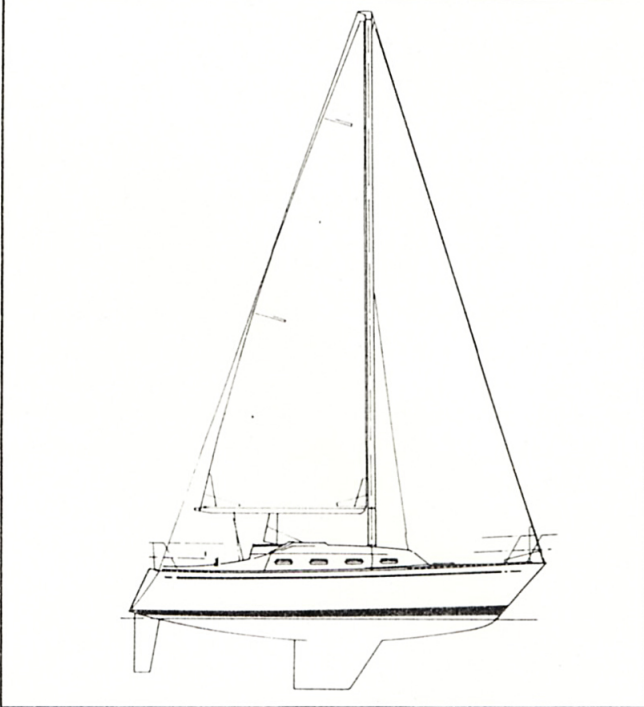


## 28'

Such sailors understand and expect the amount and variety of built-in stowage space (lockers, drawers, shelves, and bins). As with larger Tartans, the 28 has excellent light and ventilation below: eight opening ports combine with a large forward hatch and aft companionway.
