


# Tartan 28

The Tartan 28, introduced in 1984, brings the Tartan level of quality and sailing performance to those who want a true yacht under 30 feet. She is our answer to experienced cruising yachtsmen who elsewhere have found a lack of detail and less impressive construction standards in this size range.

Designed by Sparkman & Stephens (as are all other Tartan models), Tartan 28 is proof that you no longer need to go to great lengths to own a well-balanced, well-made performance cruiser. She is beautifully constructed in hand laid-up mat with unidirectional roving and reinforcement, balsa cored through the deck. Her interior uses select Burma teak, thrice wet sanded and hand rubbed, then oil finished. The attention to detail is apparent throughout.

Because Tartans traditionally have appealed to those with greater cruising experience, the appointments in the Tartan 28 seem lavish to those who have examined the under 30-foot market. Such sailors understand and expect the amount and variety of built-in stowage space (lockers, drawers, shelves, and bins). As with larger Tartans, the 28 has excellent light and ventilation below: eight opening ports combine with a large forward hatch and aft companionway.



Tartans' greatest appeal continues to be their sailing character. They are honestly fast sailers with a forgiving tendency; this lets their owners, not just professional skippers, attain optimum performance. A crew of 50-year-olds, for example, won the prestigious Block Island Week in their cruise-equipped Tartan 28 (complete with hot and cold pressure water and only two more sails than we recommend for a cruising family).
