The new Tayana 47 is another Bob Perry design commissioned by Tayana. She incorporates the latest thinking of Bob's active design office.

The 47 features a modern, relatively shoal draft keel of moderate span and an up-to-date elliptical rudder, hung on a solid, protective skeg. The hull is quite fine forward for maximum pointing, and a dry comfortable ride through the waves. She is full aft for powerful reaching and running performance.



The generous volume incorporated in her hull provides for outstanding accommodations.

The Ta Yang yard is justly famous for offering your choice of customized accommodations with exceptional attention to joinerwork, and selection of choice hardwoods, fabrics, and hardware. After all, they are the largest production builder of sailboats in the Orient, having built well over 800 boats to date.

The 47 is available with two basic layouts. The one pictured offers three private sleeping cabins. There is a two-cabin layout, and numerous variations are also available.

The 47 can be easily handled by a couple, but can accommodate three couples in luxurious privacy.

She carries 230 gallons of fresh water in three separate S.S. tanks and 120 gallons of fuel. Most tanks are located



beneath the sole which keeps the center of gravity low for extra stability, and frees up the storage space under the berths which can then be custom-tailored with your choice of drawers and/or cabinets.

Tayanas are especially appealing to experienced cruisers, who know what they want, and are surprised that they can get it at surprisingly affordable prices because of the volume that the Ta Yang yard produces—generally price-competitive with "lesser, production boats" from the U.S.
