Marine Core Construction

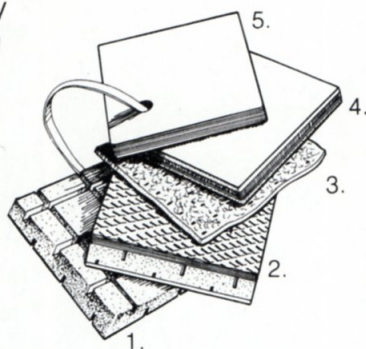
1.&2. Scored high density polyester foam is sandwiched between fiberglass top and bottom providing a highly rigid material with the lowest possible weight.

(Insulation value is an added benefit.)

3.&4. Polyester fiber matrix enclosing saran microspheres

provides great strength yet reduces weight to the practical minimum.

5. Sturdy, uniform fiberglass laminate is built up from layers of mat, random strand and woven roving for maximum strength.
