


 Cutter rig, heavy wall section spars with long-lasting white finish  
 Bowsprit platform and pulpit  
 1/4" 1x19 stainless steel standing rigging  
 1/2" turnbuckles and toggles  
 Single lifelines and stanchions  
 Four 6" portlights  
 Four 4" portlights  
 Fiberglass forward, main, and lazarette hatches  
 Teak handrails, caprails, rubrail  
 Rail stripe and boat top stripe, matching standard color  
 Anchor roller  
 Four hawse pipes
