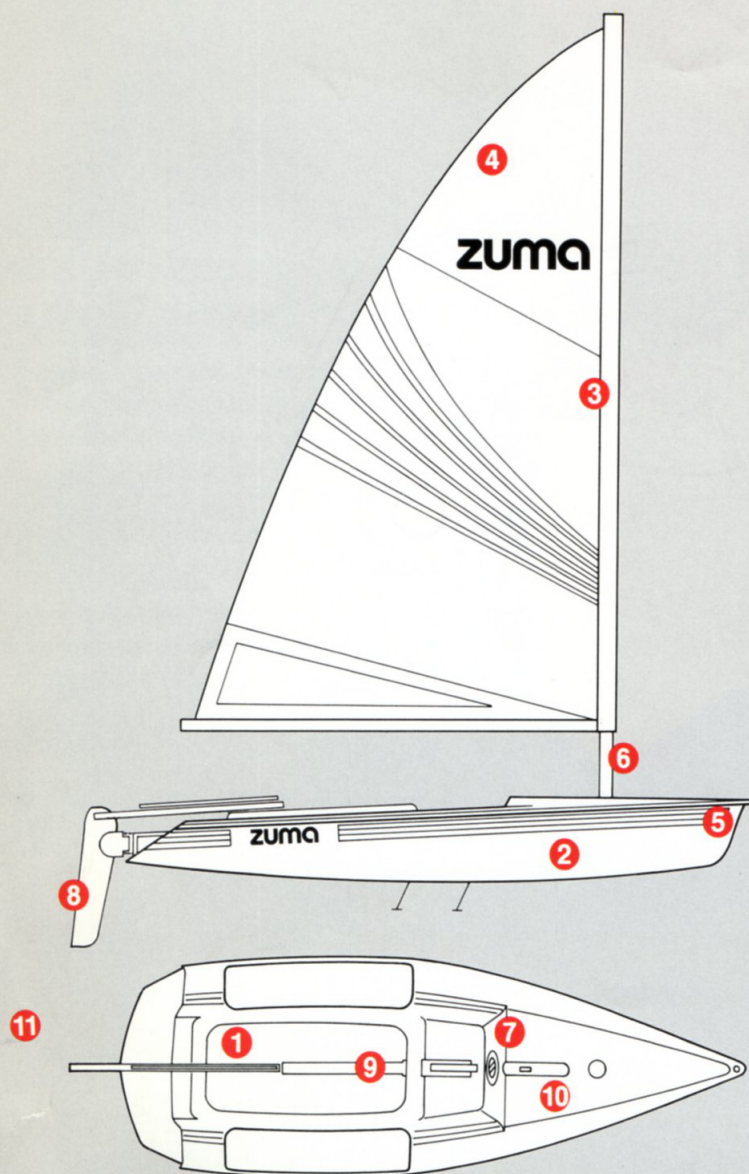

ZUMA. A quick cruise through the highlights:

- 1 Big, roomy cockpit.** Rolled cockpit sides and plenty of elbow room make ZUMA a comfortable all-day sailboat.
- 2 High-volume hull.** A hard-chine bottom gives the boat a flat "base" for a more stable ride. Positive foam flotation makes it virtually unsinkable.
- 3 Sleeved sail with halyard system.** The zippered sleeve and halyard let you raise and lower the sail without tipping the boat over on its side.
- 4 High-aspect ratio sailplan.** Concentrates sail area up high where the wind is. For faster, more exciting sailing and better control when it gets breezier.
- 5 Durable, maintenance-free finish.** Tough gelcoat over seamless hand laid-up fiberglass. Takes the hard knocks that come with learning.
- 6 Black anodized two-piece mast.** Together with the boom it nests securely and neatly in the hull for convenient cartopping. We use extra heavy grade aluminum for strength and dependability.
- 7 Inspection port with storage bag.** Provides a dry cargo area for valuables, lunch, etc. And an ingenious place to fit the mast and boom for transport and storage.
- 8 Kick-up rudder.** There's no better design when you want to run a boat right up onto the beach or cruise over shallow areas.
- 9 Hiking strap.** Secure and comfortable. So you can concentrate on sharpening your sailing skills and experience ZUMA's lively performance.
- 10 Flush deck.** What you don't see is important here; no fittings to hang up the boat as you're sliding it onto a roof rack.
- 11 Invisible advantage.** Sunfish Sailboats is the biggest name in small sailboats. That experience and reputation is behind every ZUMA we make. So is a full one-year warranty.
